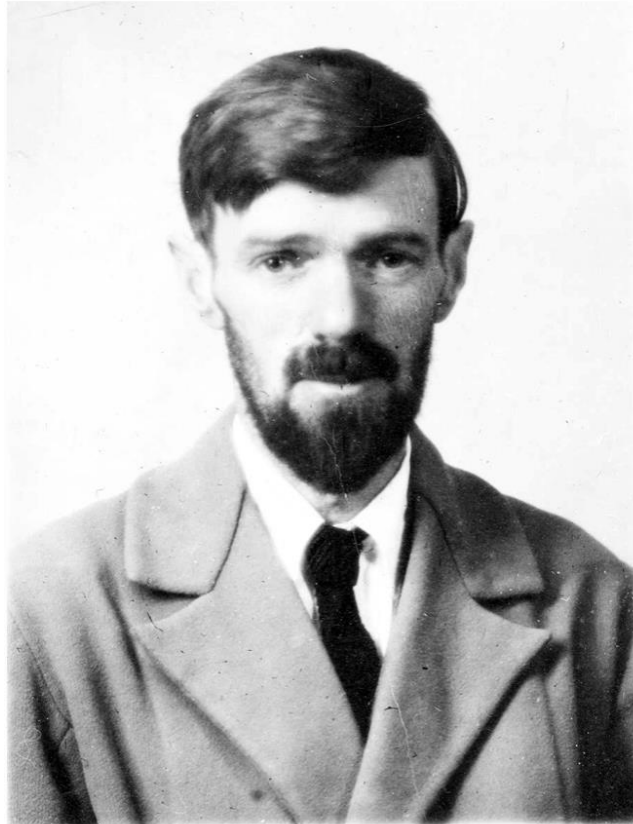

# D.H. LAWRENCE AND NOTTINGHAM'S REBEL WRITERS

D.H. Lawrence is regarded as one of the most influential writers of the 20th century and was arguably one of the most talented rebel writers in Nottingham. Previously, amorous poet Lord Byron, like DH Lawrence, was a rebellious creative. In later years Alan Sillitoe and Stanley Middleton helped to make up part of the rich cultural fabric of the city. Nottingham became a UNESCO City of Literature in December 2015 for the sheer quality and quantity of literary excellence. There are many less-well-known writers in Nottingham's history who are just as important. The Rebel Writers influenced much of the literature available to us today.
